Subject: Provincial Health Orders In Effect

Pastor Enns, staff, volunteers and members of Leamington Evangelical Mennonite Church,

The Province of Ontario has issued orders under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act which include, but are not limited to, the following measures:

- Wearing of masks is required indoors in businesses and organizations, with some exceptions; places of worship are included in the order
- Individuals are required to maintain physical distancing of two metres from other people outside of their household or social circles
- Churches may fill up to 30 per cent of the capacity of a particular room
- Indoor gatherings for public or social events are limited to 10 people; outdoor gatherings to 25 people – this includes residences, parks and other recreation areas

Hand sanitizer has also been ordered to be made available by the local Medical Officer of Health. It is strongly recommended that all persons sanitize their hands prior to entering and leaving the facility.
